Enclosed is an application form so that you can sign up **as soon as possible**. **Please note** that there is a flat fee of **\$125 per booth space for non-profit non-food vendors (must supply copy of 501c3) or \$150.00 per booth space for non-food vendors** and **\$250.00 per booth space for food vendors**.

Preference will be given to exhibitors that make their own wares. Artist in all fine art and fine craft disciplines are welcome to apply.

Please let us know your electrical requirements, the dimensions of your booth, and what you will be selling/displaying. **You must tell us all of the above on the application.** The Texas Blueberry Festival reserves the right to refuse any vendor that sells/displays something that was not listed on the original application.

NOTE THAT A CANCELLATION POLICY IS NOW SPECIFIED ON THE APPLICATION. We will also have a "Festival Contact Number" for updates. As always, we will have shuttles to parking, and we will e-mail you more information about check-in and other details closer to the event.

Please respond by May 8th to secure your space(s). (Note: We have sold out early almost every year! **Don't Delay!** **Keep this page for your records!** **See reverse for electrical outlets we can accommodate.**

Keep Nacogdoches Beautiful volunteers are on hand to help keep the venue tidy during the event and are **NOT** responsible for vendor trash. Vendors who leave their trash behind after conclusion of the event **WILL** be banned from future participation in any Nacogdoches festivals.

We ask that vendors and groups distributing candy and handouts to help remind visitors that this is a *Litter Free Event*. This message should also be promoted by speakers or costumed entertainers moving among the event visitors. Small wrappers are especially difficult to clean up as they become lodged between the brick pavement and blow into storm sewers, alleys and under vehicles.

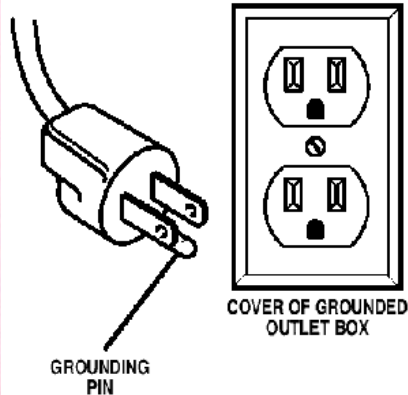
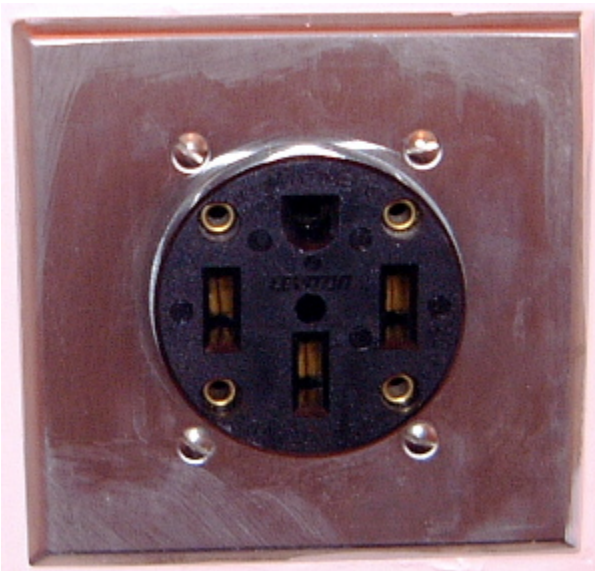

Additional Festival Guidelines
(Please keep this information for future reference)

- All food vendors must set up booths between 5:30 am and 6:30 am
- All other vendors may arrive anytime between 5:30 and 7:00 am
- All vehicles must be removed from the vendor area by 7:30 am
- No vendors will be allowed to enter the festival area after 7:15 am (NO EXCEPTIONS)
- All vendors must adhere to the KNB Litter Free Festival Guidelines concerning litter.
- All vendors must remain open from 8 – 4pm. Vendors who close early will not be invited back!
