References: Each applicant must submit **two (2) references**, limited to 200 words or less, from people who are well-acquainted with the applicant. References should include the name, address, and daytime phone number of the person making the recommendation and must also include the name and high school of NOBLE Scholar. One reference must be from an educator; the second reference could be another educator, a local business person, or a trusted adult who is not a family member. The applicant is not allowed to see the references. Each reference must be returned to the applicant in a sealed envelope, which is then attached to the application form.

Documentation: Each application must be accompanied by (1) a current unofficial high school transcript showing academic average (GPA) and grading scale through four years of high school, class size, and official ranking of application; (2) proof of either SAT or ACT scores (a photocopy of official scores); (3) an essay and (4) references. Incomplete applications will not be accepted for consideration.

Essay: The applicant must submit a copy of her/his ApplyTX essay or an essay used for any scholarship application. Please attach the copy to the application.

Deadline: Applications must be received by the Selection Committee by April 23, 2021.

Evaluation Procedure

For the purposes of evaluation of applicants, a selection committee from the education and business communities will review each application and determine scholarship recipients. Final approval of each scholarship recipient will be made on or about **April 30** of the calendar year in which the award is to be presented.

Incomplete applications will **NOT** be considered for selection.

Payment of Scholarship

Scholarships will be disbursed through the financial aid office at Stephen F. Austin State University. Payment of the scholarship will be made to the SFA financial aid office, then dispersed to the student at the rate of \$500 per semester in which the recipient is enrolled for 12 or more semester hours and is in good standing academically.

Additional scholarship funds may be available to NOBLE Scholarship recipients at SFA for years 2 and beyond. To be eligible for consideration, the recipient is required to complete the SFA common scholarship application annually. Maintaining academic good standing could allow you to have up to a \$4,000 scholarship for serving as a NOBLE Scholar.
