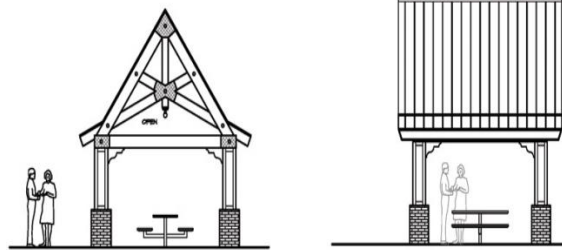
PROJECT PLAN DESCRIPTION
